

The Liverpool Health and Academic Precinct will redevelop Liverpool Hospital into an international hub of medical excellence, research and education



Works are now underway on the redevelopment of Liverpool Hospital.

The seven-year project is due for completion in late 2026 and will incorporate both refurbishment of existing spaces and the construction of new buildings, providing increased capacity, expanded services and enhanced health care for our growing community.

The exciting project will deliver:

- A larger emergency department, intensive care unit and more theatres
- Expanded neonatal intensive care unit and children's services
- Enhanced maternity and women's health services
- Integrated cancer services
- Increased ambulatory care services and outpatient clinics
- A new multi-storey car park with improved pick-up and drop-off points.
