

Since main works construction commenced earlier in the year, the site of the former hospital education centre has been a hive of activity. Earthworks and piling is underway to prepare a strong foundation for the new hospital building that will also feature a new main entrance off Goulburn Street.

Upcoming project milestones to look out for include the arrival of our newest tower crane, which is set to take its place within the main construction site next month. We're seeking the help of local primary school students to give our new crane a name – check out the details below!

Later this month, the first project tower crane, which became a feature of the Liverpool skyline in early 2021 to help construct the new multi-storey car park, will be dismantled.

As the future P2 car park nears completion, keep an eye out for news and information about hospital parking and access changes in the lead up to the scheduled opening mid-year.

Commissioning refers to all preparation works, including testing and training, that are required to ensure new spaces/buildings and the staff that will work within them are ready to receive the first patients.
