During demolition of Ron Dunbier House and the old ambulance station, 3800 tonnes of bricks and concrete will be sent for recycling/reuse – that's 96% of all materials!

The new year has seen the start of early works, including demolition and site investigations.

One of the many activities continuing around the site include investigations into what's below the ground. This information helps us improve the design of our underground services and new buildings into the future.

As well as the demolition of buildings no longer in use, visitors to the hospital over coming months will see service upgrades taking place on streets surrounding the hospital site.
