"We're excited to open the doors to the new fourstorey tower later this year, which is the first of two stages in the redevelopment of Liverpool Hospital," he said.

"The first stage will include a new main entrance, a new and expanded birthing unit, an expanded neonatal intensive care unit, a new entrance to the Emergency Department and wonderful new artworks developed with our community to complement the new building.
