



Our project mascots braved the wet weather with staff for a recent visit to the highest level of the car park

Since the turning of the first sod in December 2020, the team working on our new multi-storey car park has worked through one of the most challenging periods in construction industry history.

Project builder ADCO Constructions recently hosted a small event on site to acknowledge the workforce that has helped keep the project on track. The celebration coincided with the car park reaching its highest point in construction and included special guest speaker, Nigel Smith, who represented Australia in volleyball at the 2000 Paralympics.

Nigel shared his personal story to help raise awareness of the importance of workplace safety, after a workplace accident at the age of 25 led to the amputation of his leg.

His key message to all workers was the importance of communication, speaking up about safety and looking out for each other on the job site – reminding everyone that it’s not only about getting the work done, but protecting yourself and others around you while you do it.

Work on the car park has progressed well, despite a range of hurdles, including construction pauses, COVID-19 restrictions and unfavourable weather conditions. The project is on track for becoming operational in mid-2022.



Teams don hard hats and hi-vis for site visits

Construction site visits provide valuable insight into the dynamic work that’s undertaken daily by our project builders.

A key part of keeping our project team and hospital staff up-to-date on the hospital redevelopment, members of our corporate and engineering teams are invited to participate in monthly site visits.




With their hard hats and hi-vis vests on, the teams are able to visually observe and understand what happens within the construction site.

Our project builders are also able to provide progress updates and share achievements as works progress throughout the life of the project.

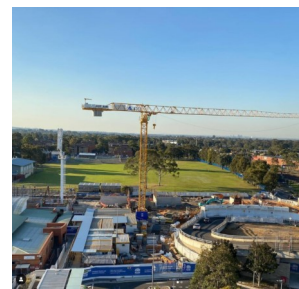
