

Things are looking different!

The commencement of main works construction is changing the face of our hospital.

Visitors will now see construction hoarding along Elizabeth and Goulburn Streets, which has permanently closed the Elizabeth Street entry (Entrance B) and the P1 car park. Alternate parking for visitors is available in P2 (off Campbell Street) and P3 (off Burnside Drive).

Alternate hospital entry points include:

Entrance L via Campbell Street – 6.30am to 8pm.
Best parking P2 (open 6am to 10pm).

Entrance J via Burnside Drive – 24 hour access.
Best parking P3 (open 6am to 9.30pm).

Entrance N via Campbell Street – 7am to 6pm
Monday to Friday. Best parking P2 (open 6am to 10pm).

Along with these changes, the hospital Information Desk has also moved to Entrance J.

External access to the Emergency Department and the Emergency drop-off zone on Elizabeth Street has not been impacted.

To help you find your way, we've installed new signage around the hospital campus, highlighting entrance points and parking options.

Spotlight on the Brennan Unit

Construction is underway on the first brand new space of the project. The Brennan Unit (Forensics) team are excitedly awaiting completion of their new space, which is scheduled for later this year. This will be the first department to move into its final location as part of main works.

New ceiling examination lights, larger treatment rooms and new ways of working will enhance the flow of operations and patient care. The new unit will also be co-located within the Emergency Department, enabling a more functional environment for patients and staff.

Dr Tania May, Brennan Unit Medical Director, said the team were looking forward to moving into their new space.

“We’ve worked closely with the redevelopment team and Emergency Department representatives to redesign and enhance the new department, and we’re really excited to see how it all comes together,” she said.

On the rise...

The new seven-storey car park continues to grow and take shape as it rises tall on the hospital campus with the assistance of Celsus, our very busy tower crane.

In line with the current public health orders, our builders are working closely with the redevelopment project team to ensure construction works can continue as scheduled. A range of COVID-safe measures are in place, including mask wearing on site. Our project mascot Toolman Ted recently donned his own face mask to visit the construction team and check out how works are progressing.

Concrete pours for the lower three levels are now complete, with suspended slabs underway on levels four and five.

As construction of the car park continues, planning for the façade is currently underway. The exterior of the car park is set to feature a creative art design, developed by an Indigenous artist in consultation with the community. We’re looking forward to sharing details in a future edition before the big reveal when scaffolding comes down later in the year.
