Major milestone for the redevelopment of Liverpool Hospital

Lendlease has been appointed as principal builder for the Liverpool Health and Academic Precinct, which will deliver enhanced health care for south western Sydney.

Now undertaking site preparation for the main works component of the redevelopment project, Lendlease joins multi-storey car park builders ADCO Constructions on delivery of the \$790 million Liverpool Health and Academic Precinct.

The first stage of main works will see a range of access changes in place, impacting pedestrians and vehicles travelling to the hospital. Construction hoarding is currently being installed around the Elizabeth/Goulburn Street entry of the hospital. This is to enable site establishment in preparation for safe demolition of hospital buildings and future construction of new hospital buildings.

From Wednesday 15 September, there will be a range of hospital access changes, with alternate routes in place. Please see the next page for details.

Liverpool Hospital General Manager, Karen McMenamin, said the project would support

thousands of jobs both during construction and on completion, boosting the local economy.

“The commencement of main works is a major milestone for the Liverpool community and I cannot wait to see the end result in 2026,” she said.

“The redevelopment will see expanded clinical services and public spaces, integrated with research and teaching, providing the community with enhanced health care for years to come.”

Construction of the new buildings is expected to be complete in late 2026.

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Key features of the main works package

Main works construction activities will include demolition of existing buildings, construction of new hospital buildings and refurbishment of key hospital spaces. To enable services to continue while construction is underway, the works will be programmed across two stages, with refurbishment works to be staggered across both stages.

Stage 1 is scheduled for completion in 2023.

Key features include:

- New birthing unit
- Expanded neonatal intensive care unit
- New pathology department
- Additional medical imaging department
- Emergency Department expansion
- A new hospital main entrance

This stage will be complemented by completion of the new multi-storey car park expected in 2022.

Stage 2 is scheduled for completion in late 2026.

Key features include:

- New integrated services building including:
 - ◇ New inpatient units
 - ◇ Integrated cancer centre including the Australian Cancer Research Foundation (ACRF) Oasis Wellness Centre
 - ◇ Increased women's ambulatory care
 - ◇ Enhanced corporate support services
- Emergency Department refurbishment

Upcoming hospital changes

The commencement of main works will see major access changes for those travelling to the hospital. The P1 car park is now permanently closed, with alternate parking available in P2 (off Campbell Street) and P3 (off Burnside Drive).

From Wednesday 15 September, construction hoarding installed along Elizabeth and Goulburn Streets will see the permanent closure of the Elizabeth Street entry (Entrance B).

Following the Entrance B closure, pedestrians will be required to use alternate hospital entry points:

Entrance L via Campbell Street | **Entrance J** via Burnside Drive | **Entrance N** via Campbell Street
