Here's what you need to know!

Important access changes

Access to Liverpool Hospital will now be available on Goulburn Street, and includes:

- New public entrance: Entrance A
- New drop-off/pick-up zone
- **Parking:** P1 will reopen off Goulburn Street.

Getting to the new entrance

Vehicles and pedestrian access: The new public entrance is accessible via Goulburn Street, with the best parking available at P1.

Public transport: The bus stop remains at the corner of Elizabeth and Goulburn Streets, near the new entrance.

Parking: Liverpool Hospital parking is accessible via **P1** on Goulburn Street, and **P2** and **P3** on Burnside Drive.

Introducing the new Liverpool Hospital building

The NSW Government is investing \$830 million in the redevelopment of Liverpool Hospital including a new car park, providing a major expansion and upgrade of essential health services for the Liverpool community.

The Liverpool Health and Academic Precinct redevelopment is being delivered in two stages. **Stage 1** includes:

- State-of-the-art Birthing and Neonatal Intensive Care Units
- A new Emergency Department entrance opening 2025
- A centralised Pathology Department
- Enhanced outpatient and support services including Cancer and Haematology Services.

Stage 2 of the redevelopment is expected to be completed by 2027, with ongoing renovation works occurring progressively within the existing hospital throughout the project.
